HAIS Member Benefits Defined

Accreditation Support - In advance of the accreditation visit, schools can get support in drafting and revising the self-study as well as receive accreditation-focused professional development opportunities for the entire staff or focus groups. For the accreditation visits themselves, the Director of Accreditation builds teams comprised of individuals who understand the needs and goals of our independent schools in Hawai'i. HAIS also serves as a WASC Liaison

New Heads of School Mentoring - New heads of school are paired with seasoned heads who provide support and guidance during the first year of headship.

Education Fairs - Held in September of each year on Oahu and Maui , this event is free and open to the public and provides an opportunity to learn about HAIS member schools.

Global Issues Network - Annual Student Conference aimed at empowering young people to collaborate locally, regionally, and globally, in order to create project-based sustainable solutions for global issues.

HAIS Re-Use - Member schools are able to post items that they would like to donate to other schools (ex: iPads, computers, office furniture, etc).

Kupuna Consulting - Access to an experienced team of consultants who offer a unique service that is customized to meet the needs of each school.

Listserv Communication Groups - Ability to join constituency email groups and participate in job-alike discussions and events.

Member Only Resources - Access to resources and information, on the HAIS website.

Private School Guide - Annual publication created in partnership with HONOLULU Magazine, featuring member schools.

Salary and Staff Survey - Conducted by the Hawaii Employers' Council, the results offer data on salary and staff information at HAIS member schools and is only available to participating full and provisional members. All data provided is confidential and presented in a manner that guards the identification of participants.

Service on Accreditation Teams - Educators and administrators from HAIS member schools have the opportunity to serve on HAIS/WASC accreditation teams.

Standard Online Application (SAO) - Free application program, in partnership with the Enrollment Management Association (EMA), which will ease the application process for families and increase visibility for HAIS member schools.
